Re: Letter of Resolution –Blairton Terrace Development

At its Regular Meeting of Council on October 17, 2017, Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Marmora and Lake passed the following motion:

That Council send a letter to the Council of Havelock-Belmont-Methuen requesting to be circulated on any correspondence with regards to the proposed development of Blairton Terrace being completed by Fairtrade Works on Crowe Lake. Council further advises that the Municipality of Marmora and Lake would be interested in participating in a Lake Capacity Study on Crowe Lake with the Township of Havelock-Belmont Methuen.

It has been brought to our attention by the Crowe Lake Waterway Association that there is a proposal in place for development on Crowe Lake in the Township of Havelock-Belmont-Methuen.

A copy of the correspondence provided to the Crowe Lake Waterway Association by Havelock-Belmont-Methuen was circulated to Council on October 17, 2017. Ritch Smith, President of the Crowe Lake Waterway Association attended as a delegation and discussed his concerns with the Blairton Terrace Development, being completed by Fairtrade Works.

The Municipality of Marmora and Lake has also been approached by Fair Trade Works for a proposed development on Crowe Lake for which the Crowe Lake Waterway Association has also voiced concerns.

As such, the above resolution would request that any further correspondence received regarding the Blairton Terrace Development be circulated to our municipality. The Municipality would also circulate to Havelock-Belmont-Methuen any correspondence received with regards to the Crowhill Estates Proposed Development. I would like to advise that to date, there is not a formal application submitted on the proposed development.

Council also discussed the possible need for an updated Lake Capacity Study for Crowe Lake and would like to advise that they would be interested in a joint lake capacity study being completed for both municipalities.
